**An Act to amend the Dietitians Act 1950**

[27 November 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Dietitians Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Act 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Registrar of Dietitians**—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 3 (as substituted by section 2 (1) of the Dietitians Amendment Act 1964), and substituting the following section:

“3. (1) There shall from time to time be appointed under the State Services Act 1962 for the purposes of this Act a Registrar of Dietitians who shall be a registered dietitian employed in the Department of Health.

“(2) The Registrar shall have the powers and duties laid down in this Act, and shall perform such other duties as are for the time being prescribed by regulations made under this Act.”

(2) Section 2 of the Dietitians Amendment Act 1964 is hereby consequentially repealed.

**3. Regulations**—Section 32 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“(3) Any such regulations may—

“(a) Entitle or require the Board, for the purpose of deciding the result of any examination conducted by the Board under this Act and taken by a candidate, to take into consideration the result of any examination, project, assignment, or other test, undertaken by the candidate during the course of his training at a training school which is for the time being approved by the Board under this Act; and

“(b) Impose conditions, or authorise the Board to impose conditions, subject to which any such power may be exercised or any such duty may be performed.”
