An Act to amend the Factories and Commercial Premises Act 1981 *[12 December 1983]*

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Factories and Commercial Premises Amendment Act 1983, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories and Commercial Premises Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Interpretation—Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (9), and substituting the following subsection:

“(9) For the purposes of Parts III and IV of this Act, while—

“(a) Any school pupil is placed in any undertaking as part of a work experience scheme or work exploration scheme; or

“(b) Any other person is placed by the Secretary, or by any person or body of persons (whether incorporated or not) authorised by the Secretary to do so, in any undertaking as part of a job exploration scheme or a work-based training scheme,—

that pupil or person shall be deemed to be employed in that undertaking; and the provisions of those Parts of this Act shall apply to that pupil or person accordingly.”

This Act is administered in the Department of Labour.
