Title.

An Act to amend "The Otago Harbour Board Empowering Act, 1875." [18th October, 1884.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is desirable that no difference should be made between the rates charged by the Otago Harbour Board for goods, wares, and merchandise landed at Port Chalmers and those landed at Dunedin:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Otago Harbour Board Empowering Act 1875 Amendment Act, 1884."

Harbour improvement rate at Port Chalmers to be the same as at Dunedin. 2. Section twelve of "The Otago Harbour Board Empowering Act, 1875," is hereby repealed.

Board shall maintain railway piers in repair. 3. As soon as the railway piers have been put in an efficient state of repair, and have been handed over to the Otago Harbour Board, the said Board shall maintain and keep the said piers in repair.
