1959, No. 10—*Local*

An Act to vest further powers in the Otago Harbour Board
[18 September 1959]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Otago Harbour Board Empowering Act 1959.

2. Interpretation—In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

“Board” means the Otago Harbour Board:

“Corporation” means the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Dunedin.

3. Special Act—This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act 1950.

4. Increase in area of land to be set aside—Subsection one of section four of the Otago Harbour Board Lands Vesting Act 1910 is hereby amended by omitting the words “ten acres”, and substituting the words “ten acres nineteen perches and nine-tenths of a perch”, and the said section four as so amended shall be read and construed and shall apply in all

respects as if the words "ten acres nineteen perches and nine-tenths of a perch" had originally appeared therein in place of the words "ten acres".

5. Transfer of land to Dunedin City Corporation—Whereas the Board and the Corporation have agreed that the Board shall transfer to the Corporation the area of land described in the Schedule hereto as the Board's provision for reserves under the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 in respect of the Board's subdivisions at Black Jack's Point and the South Endowment: Be it therefore enacted as follows: The Board is hereby authorised to transfer the said area of land to the Corporation free of any payment whatsoever, and the said land shall be held by the Corporation as a public reserve subject to the provisions of the Reserves and Domains Act 1953.
